a. New Access Ramp Works

To consider and agree to a variation in the specification for the works to install a new access ramp already approved to include an additional tarmacadamed path running from the Men's Toilets to the Nadder Close Car Park at a quoted cost of £2,800 ex VAT.

b. Dropped Kerb

To consider and agree to an additional action to provide a fully accessible route from the Car Park to the Public Toilets through the installation of a dropped kerb at a quoted cost of £1,850 ex VAT.
